Funding provided by: Calgary Eye Foundation

Overview:

The funding will support new research initiatives to facilitate the acquisition of preliminary results or provide bridge funding for established projects in vision research. Support for hypothesis-driven, clinical scientific work will be given priority over work related to surgical instrument development or descriptions of surgical procedures or techniques.

Funding available: 4 grants of \$2,500 each.

Applications are open to Ophthalmology medical students, residents, fellows and faculty.

Application deadline: October 4, 2021

Award announcement: December 1, 2021

Presentation: all successful applicants must present Calgary's annual Research Day 2022

- The application form must be completed in its entirety (including signatures) when applying.
- It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the application is complete and received at the Calgary Eye Foundation inbox by **MONDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2021 , 6 PM MST**

- It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the application has been received. Incomplete applications (including those lacking any of the required signatures) will be considered ineligible.
- One copy of the application and all attachments must be submitted, with required signatures.
- Project/Funding duration and Budget must be clearly identified.
